Full-time, fixed-term for 12 months

We are seeking a highly-motivated Research Fellow to work on the EC industry-academia partnerships project of research on China's electricity industry (IAPP-218246: CEI-EGE). This project aims at providing a comprehensive and detailed economic and technical assessment of the current reform and sustainable development of China's power industry. The project is in collaboration with other two European institutions, Brunel University, United Kingdom, and Swiss Electricity Ltd, Geneva-Switzerland.

The potential candidate must have obtained a PhD in economics or finance with relevant four-to-ten-year quantitative or macro-econometric-modelling research experience ideally in China's industry, energy and economy. He/she will be expected principally to conduct research on macro modelling of electricity demand, as well as to coordinate parties involved in the research and to manage an effective liaison with our Chinese collaborative institutions and other exchanges about the research. Knowledge of Mandarin will be a plus but is not mandatory.

Eligibility

Nationals of a member state of the EU (except France), of an associated state or of any other third country, including China. Applicants should not have lived in France for more than 12 months in the last three years.

Salary

Fellows will receive the standard EC Marie Curie Living Allowance of around 3,350 € per month and in addition an allowance for travel, mobility and career exploration.

The post will be based at GREQAM (<http://greqam.univ-mrs.fr/?lang=en>), in Marseille for a year and will start on October 1st. 2010. Candidates are advised to make prior enquiries by contacting Professor Eric Girardin (eric.girardin@univmed.fr) coordinator of the project.
